

The Future of Writing Centers in Europe - looking back and forward

Over the last 15 years, the number of writing centers at European universities has grown. Looking at the writing centers in the USA, this European writing center history is still quite young. Nevertheless, we in Europe are asking ourselves what the future of European writing centers looks like? What developments are there within the educational system, what global developments and challenges are shaping and changing the work in writing centers? What do we need to rethink, what do we need to change and which concepts are still proving to be productive? How are digital changes influencing our work and how can we adapt to the constantly changing student groups in order to meet their needs?

The European Writing Center Association (EWCA), together with "Journal for Writing Research' (JoSch), invites submissions on the thematic focus: "Tthe future of European Writing Centers".

Writing scholars and practitioners are invited to take stock of regional and transnational directions in writing center research or practice and reimagine their futures. How have local practices or narratives impacted regional 'Ideas' of a writing center? And what might the future of writing centers look like in your center, region, or transnational context transnationally? The planned JoSch edition thus follows on from the EWCA 2024 conference theme: "The Future of Writing Centers" (11.-14.06.2024); the call is aimed at contributors to the conference and anyone else who is interested.
